James Rose of Severn Athletic Club followed up his runaway victory in the Dymock Half Marathon with a third place in the Worcester Pitchcroft 10K in 35:49. "I got settled into third place after 2 Kilometres and held it. The first two got away early and I could only close up near the end".

Results: 1st Ian Radford, Black Pear Joggers 33:56, 80th Kevin Probyn(V45) 49:07, 142 John James(V65) 61:17. 162 ran.

The second placer at Dymock clubmate Chris Brown led home the runners in the Gloucester North Parkrun 5K with a new course PB of 18:23. Dad Andy(V55) was 21st in 21:40 and mum Sandra(LV55) was 69th in 29:04. 118 ran.
