In the Frampton 10 Kilometre Road Race Severn Athletic Club's top duo Chris Brown and James Rose featured prominently in the group chasing down the leaders. Brown challenged former club mate Mark James, who took third in 34:55. Brown was fourth in 35:20. Rose started slower then pulled through to finish seventh in 35:56. Other Severn finishers were: 61st Andy Brown(V55) 41:47, 137th Kevin Probyn(V45) 47:11 & 347 John James(V65) 58:46. 486 ran.
